

The Police Officer Assistance Trust (POAT) was established in 1989 in conjunction with the Miami-Dade County Association of Chiefs of Police and The Two Hundred Club of Greater Miami to assist any federal state, county, local, or corrections law enforcement officer and/or family that is stricken with a catastrophic event.



Since the inception of POAT, approximately \$4 million has been provided to officers in 39 different law enforcement agencies in Miami-Dade County.



The POAT is also responsible for maintaining and enhancing the Law Enforcement Memorial located at Tropical Park, as well as coordinating the Law Enforcement Memorial Ceremony each May.



The POAT is embarking on an endeavor to erect a K-9 Memorial to honor and recognize police K-9 work dogs that have died in the line of duty and served the Miami-Dade County community. The K-9 Memorial will be located in close proximity to the Law Enforcement Memorial.
